What Is It??

The St. Albert RCMP Youth

Academy is a 6 day overnight camp that simulates the RCMP Training Academy named "Depot".

The youth "cadets" learn about policing through lectures and practical, hands-on lessons taught by actual RCMP officers.

Cadets will learn to work as a troop while they get the "inside view" of the RCMP world.

Cadets will earn 5 work experience credits as they learn about a possible career in the RCMP.

Parents, family and friends will be invited to the Academy graduation that will be held on the last day of the camp.



Applications will be accepted from:

- Grade 10 to 12 students
- Who have a genuine interest in policing
- Who have good attendance at school

Applicants must:

- Have a complete application
- Have a letter of recommendation from a teacher or a School Administrator
- Have completed the Work Experience pre-requisites as outlined by the Work Experience Coordinator
- Display a willingness to work
- Be physically and medically fit
- Pass the interview and fitness test
- Pay \$400.00 to cover food and supplies
- Inform Your School that they pay \$200 to cover course costs
- Respect the Academy rules



What Happens Next??

Once the successful Cadets are selected, they will:

- be notified by e-mail and/or letter of acceptance
- start recording their fitness logs and will read over their Academy material
- Attend a parent/ Cadet orientation meeting
- Be sized for their Academy "uniforms"
- Receive their camp supply list and prepare for the camp
